

# Road Safety Rules Worksheet

Read the passage below and see if you can complete all the road safety rules. You can check your rules by looking back at the website [www.3Mstreetwise.com](http://www.3Mstreetwise.com). Once you have all the rules written down correctly, keep these rules somewhere you can see them to remind you.

## When walking along the road

Always walk on the \_\_\_\_\_ or path if there is one.

Walk along the pavement as \_\_\_\_\_ away from the road as possible.

Where there is no pavement, walk in single file on the \_\_\_\_\_ side of the road, facing on-coming traffic.

## Crossing the road

Find the safest place to cross then \_\_\_\_\_ and face the road so drivers can see you are waiting to cross.

If you can't find a \_\_\_\_\_ (footbridges, Zebra, Pelican, Puffin or traffic light crossings), choose a place where you can \_\_\_\_\_ clearly along the roads in all directions, and where drivers can see you.

Never cross on sharp \_\_\_\_\_ or just before the top of a \_\_\_\_\_.

Look all around for \_\_\_\_\_.

\_\_\_\_\_ carefully because you can sometimes hear traffic before you can see it.

## If traffic is coming, let it pass.

Do not cross unless there is a safe \_\_\_\_\_ and you are sure there is plenty of \_\_\_\_\_.

When it's safe, \_\_\_\_\_ straight across the road. Don't run.

Keep looking and listening for traffic while you \_\_\_\_\_.
